4. How was the event planned/executed?
5. How was the event promoted? Illustrate the ways you used newspapers, radio, Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, blogs, TV, etc. Include copies of articles, screenshots of posts and links to News casts.
6. List your goals for the event? Were your goals met?
7. How was the event a success?
